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The manuscripts of Buchelius in the University Library of Utrecht and elsewhere



INTRODUCTION

The University Library of Utrecht has the most extensive manuscript collection of Aernout van Buchell / Arnoldus Buchelius (1565-1641). It is a most diverse collection, including diaries, poetry, notations about painters or women, letters and collections of letters, lists of the books in his library, historical writings, heraldry, genealogies, depictions of (funeral) monuments and all sorts of notes and observations. These are collected in about 50 titles with a separate shelfmark. There are 26 titles in the catalogue of Pieter Anton Tiele (*Catalogus codicum manu scriptorum bibliothecae universitatis Rheno-trajectinae*, vol. 1, 1887) (between Ms. 761 and Ms. 1324). The 17 titles acquired afterwards (between Ms. 1640 en Ms. 1867) are in the catalogue of Abraham Hulshof (vol. 2, 1909) (both digitised, link via [WorldCat](#)). Afterwards, several more documents were acquired (between Ms. 0 A 21 and Ms. 17 A 13), some as part of other collections. Among the printed books from Buchelius' library is a copy in which there are so many annotations that it is also regarded as a manuscript (Ms. 1893). There are also a few related documents about genealogy and Buchelius' manuscripts that are of importance.

The list below gives the catalogue number and/or the shelfmark (place in the depot), followed by the title of the manuscript based on the one given by Tiele or Hulshof (on its turn often based on the title given by Buchelius himself), although it may be simplified or clarified. The Latin titles (simplified or not) are the ones usually found in modern literature.

Almost all of Buchelius' manuscripts in Utrecht University Library (Universiteitsbibliotheek Utrecht = UBU) have been digitised, and the links of these digitised manuscripts are given via WorldCat (where one can also find a summary description of the manuscript in question). In the list below there are also links added when there is an article about the manuscript on the Special Collections website of the UBU, and if there is an edition (usually by Kees Smit).

After the manuscripts in the Utrecht University Library there follows a list of manuscripts elsewhere, both in the Netherlands and abroad (Germany and England). This list is based on the list in Judith Pollmann, *Religious choice in the Dutch Republic: the reformation of Arnoldus Buchelius (1565-1641)* (Manchester, 1999); Dutch edition: *Een andere weg naar God: De reformatie van Arnoldus Buchelius (1565-1641)* (Amsterdam, 2000), p. 313-318 (link via [DBNL](#), including the sections 'Gedrukte werken met bijdragen van Arnoldus Buchelius' and 'Uitgaven van Arnoldus Buchelius' handschriften').
